BRINGING GOD GLORY IN OUR CIRCUMSTANCES (Exodus 14:1-4)

Why did God lead the Israelites to the edge of the sea with the army of Egypt behind them and nowhere to go? They cried out (Ex 14:11), "Why have you done this to us?" but they were asking the wrong question.

I. ASKING THE RIGHT QUESTION

- 1. Fact: Life brings dilemmas.
- 2. Our natural instinct is to ask, "God why have you let this happen?"
- 3. The right Q: "How can I glorify God in this situation?" (Ex 14:3-4)
- 4. Our troubles are to be an opportunity for God to be glorified. (Psalm 136)

II. GLORIFYING GOD IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN OUR COMFORT

- 1. In John 9 a man who was born blind.
- 2. In John 11 Lazarus was deathly ill.
- 3. In John 12:27-28; Jesus faced His own death on the cross.
- Our lives are to be about bringing glory to God. (Ps 115:1)
- 4. The right question: "God how will You gain glory through this situation?"

III. GOD WILL DELIVER HIS PEOPLE IN HIS OWN WAY...FOR HIS GLORY!

- 1. God always intended to gain glory by saving Israel from Egypt.
- 2. God's ways are not our ways; He allows and uses difficulty to bring Him honor and glory.
- 3. He may not deliver in my way or timing...but God will deliver!

Closing:

- 1. It is comforting to know God's plan is to deliver His children.
- 2. Our question when trouble comes is not, "Why?" but...

"Heavenly Father, "How can I glorify You in this situation?"
